Homicide Anniversary

(WICHITA, Kan.) - Crime Stoppers of Wichita – Sedgwick County is asking for help from the community in locating Jakob Oneil Cuble, who is wanted in connection to a homicide that occurred one year ago.

On May 20, 2020, Marcus Sain was shot and killed during a drug transaction at an apartment complex in the 1100 block of South Webb Road in Wichita. Since then, Wichita Police Department Detectives have been able to identify three people involved in his murder, thanks to information from the public.

Two of those people, Nathaniel Saunders and Malcolm Ganther, are currently in custody. Jakob Cuble has not yet been located. We are once again asking for the public's help on this case.

The Sedgwick County District Attorney's Office has charged Cuble with First Degree Murder and Aggravated Robbery. His current whereabouts are unknown. Cuble is 19 years old, with brown eyes and black hair. He is 5'6" tall and weighs 120 pounds.

Anyone with information regarding Cuble's location is eligible to receive a reward by submitting a tip through Crime Stoppers by calling 316-267-2111 or online at www.stopcrime316.com. Tipsters are always anonymous – Crime Stoppers will never ask someone to identify themselves. If your information leads to an arrest in this case, you could be eligible to receive up to \$2,500.
