Aggravated Assault, 17th and Oliver

(WICHITA, Kan.) – Crime Stoppers of Wichita-Sedgwick County is seeking information regarding an aggravated assault that took place on December 10th near 17th Street N and N Oliver in Wichita, KS.

At approximately 4:20 p.m. on December 10th, Wichita Police Department officers responded to a suspicious character with a weapon in the area of 17th and Oliver. 911 callers reported hearing shots fired and seeing someone run from the area.

Officers located spent shell casings and some vehicle/structure damage in the area, but no one was injured. Video was obtained from a Ring camera that shows a male suspect wearing all red sneak through an alley and fire shots across Oliver – toward the East – at another male wearing all black. The male wearing all black returns fire before both leave the area.
