** News Release ** \$2,300 in rewards Approved by Crime Stoppers in June

Crime Stoppers of Wichita-Sedgwick County approved \$2,300 in cash rewards for anonymous tipsters in June. These tipsters provided tips with information that led to the arrest of 10 individuals on felony cases.

One individual was arrested after a search warrant was served at his house, which resulted in felony charges of possession of narcotics with intent to distribute. A documented gang member was arrested for felony warrants and was found in possession of a stolen firearm. These are examples of the great work being done by area law enforcement to solve and prevent crime.

"Crime Stoppers continues to be a great resource for citizens to report on crime and wanted persons, while remaining completely anonymous," said Crime Stoppers Coordinator Officer Kevin Wheeler. "We want to continue to reward those who are speaking out and providing valuable information to our program."
