Crime Stoppers Tips Lead to Arrests in High Profile Cases

Recent Crime Stoppers tips helped lead to the arrests of two suspects in two different cases, including a homicide case.

David Pressley, 42, was arrested on Oct. 5 by the Wichita Police Department. At approximately 12:30 a.m., on Sunday, Sept. 29, Damario Cooks was shot outside of Magoos Bar and Grill located in the 2300 block of S. Oliver. Pressley was identified as a person of interest in the fatal shooting of 29-year-old Cooks. Local media assisted in the call for action for the community to help locate Pressley. An anonymous Crime Stoppers tip helped lead officers to Pressley's location, and he was arrested without incident. Pressley was charged with second-degree murder.

An anonymous tip also helped lead to the arrest of Wade Dunn, 30. Dunn is accused of stabbing a 28-year-old woman multiple times in a random incident on Sept. 23. Dunn was arrested within 24-hours of the tip being received.

"Time and time again, we have experienced great success in helping solve crime when we work together as stakeholders in the Crime Stoppers program," said Crime Stoppers Chair Stacey
